Are you eligible for financial help through the Scholarship Fund?



What are the West Country Dairy Awards?

Established in the 1930s the awards provide grants to people studying courses related to the dairy industry.

Who is eligible?

Students of all ages undertaking further education courses relating to dairying.

What qualifies as the West Country?

Anyone living in Cornwall, Devon, Dorset or Somerset at the time of their application. Applicants need to demonstrate a connection and commitment to the dairy industry. There is no restriction on the place to study - with one winner even going to New Zealand.

How much money is awarded?

The awards distribute over £15,000 every year. All qualifying applicants receive some funding and the best four receive between £1,000 & £2,000.

When is the application date?

Applications close on 31 July each year.

How are the applications assessed?

All applicants are interviewed within their county and the best go forward to a final interview usually held in late September.
