



- Variation in structure and virulence of the microbial community of sheep udders (University of Warwick)
- Measuring C sequestration in managed grasslands (The James Hutton Institute)



- Improving design of pig buildings to reduce C footprint(Harper Adams)
- Predicting leg soundness through bio-mechanical assessment of gait in pigs (University of Newcastle)

- Minimising post-harvest losses
- Genetic mapping and high throughput phenotyping of fruit quality traits in *Fragaria* x ananassa



- Increasing energy from wheat straw (University of Nottingham)
- Effect of virus TuYV on quality in oilseed rape (John Innes Centre)



- Minimising susceptibility to bruising in potato (University of Leeds)
- Understanding and controlling late blight epidemics (James Hutton Institute)


