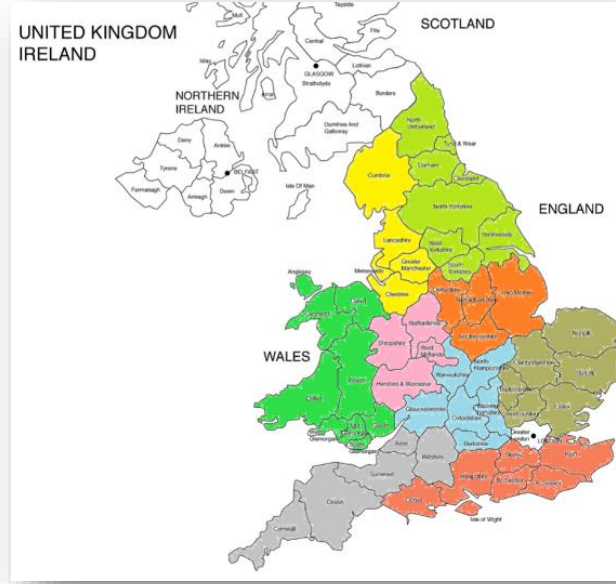


We help **farmers** navigate the world of education and support them in delivering inspiring and engaging on-farm and in-classroom activities.

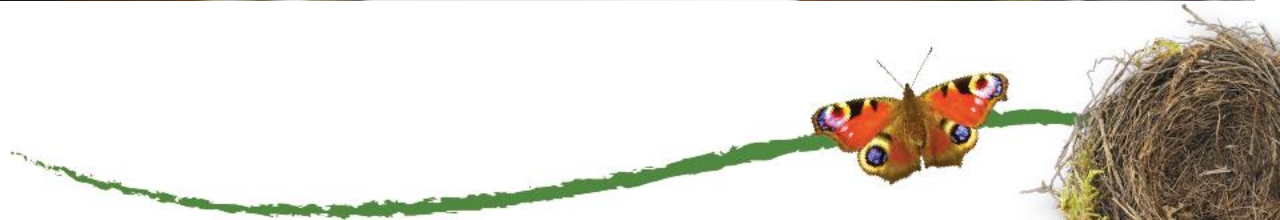

- 67% interested / keen to know more

- 75% think science and innovation will underpin sustainable farming and food production in the future



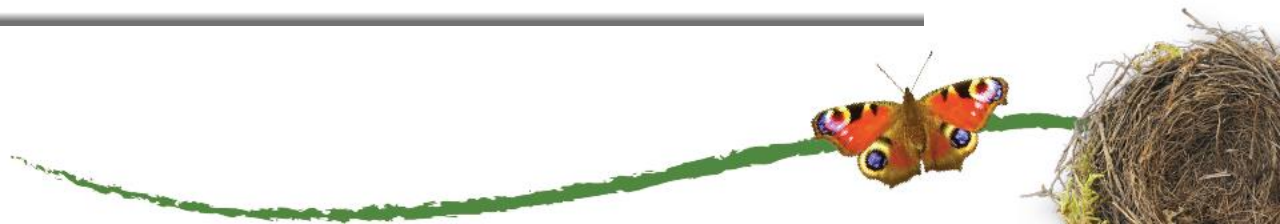
#FarmMyFood

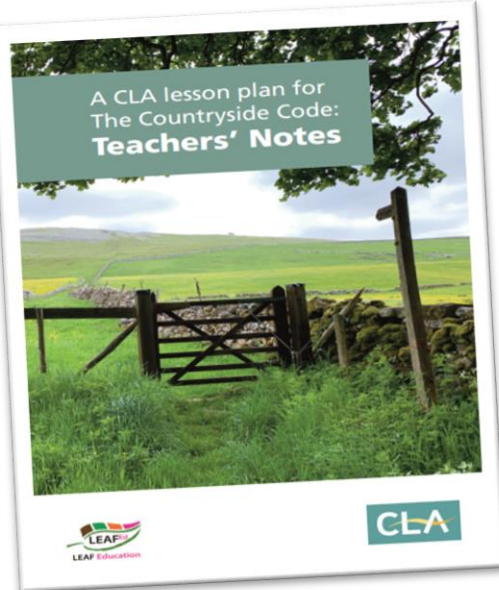
